

A bar is a public place. Public but familiar for a whole group of individuals. A representation of the imaginary. A break-out from external public areas. A representation of the imaginary. A pread-countrie external public areas. The intensity of being, being together. A complete undressing of the building, followed by a reconstruction on a dual scale: deconstruction of the Brussels type architectural structure which results in a dual-proportioned volume. A vertical and horizontal game which dislocates visual percep-tions and renders them equally essential, then restructuring of this space thanks to a material, resin, which is characteristic of furniture and lighting (which are one and the same here). This place, constructed as it is, is pro-portioned as much by the material as in the material. The furniture defines and embodies the bar.
